Instructions for attending Highfield R&P Club (Tuesday Night Only)

Members wishing to attend the Club on Tuesday nights MUST pay attention to the following instructions.

You will be required to sign an Indemnity form/waiver for every attendance. Please include your contact details. Please bring your own pen as you will still have to sign the Range Log (as required by law) including your arrival and departure times.

<u>You must be free of any symptoms of Covid-19</u> and have not been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the last 30 days.

If you look unwell in any way the Range Officer has the right to deny you entry to the Club.

You must provide and wear a face covering (mask) in the Club whilst not shooting.

Please use the hand sanitiser by the entrance on your way in and the hand sanitiser in the kitchen on your way out.

You must have all your own equipment e.g. ear defenders, mats, scopes etc. (sharing of guns and equipment is not allowed).

When entering the Clubroom you must put your equipment in the workspace allocated to you by the Range Officer. You will be expected to clean your workspace on arrival and departure and other areas if instructed to by the Range Officer, with the anti-bacterial wipes supplied by the Club.

You will be able to purchase ammunition from the Range Officer (payment will be invoiced to you by the Treasurer monthly to be paid by BACS).

Targets and target boards will be provided to you by the Range Officer.

If you need to use a Club rifle you must clean it before and after with the anti-bac wipes.

Attendance is by pre-booking only.

Numbers are limited to 8 shooters per session on the 20 yard range (the Air Weapons range will not be available until further notice). All disciplines will be able to attend but only shooting from the 20 Yard Firing Point.

<u>Booking is by text message only.</u> Text Clive Ward: **07985 734767** <u>before 12 Noon</u> on the Tuesday you wish to attend and you will receive confirmation by return text that your space is booked. If the evening you want is full you will be given first choice for the following week. Your text will be used to inform the Range Officer that you are attending and to calculate your Range Fees at the end of the month which will be invoiced to you along with any ammunition purchases. If you fail to attend your allotted night you will still be charged the Range Fee. <u>DO NOT</u> turn up if you have not pre-booked as you will not be on the Range Officers list and may be turned away.

The Range Officer will issue instructions on target changing and shooting details. Shooting details will be a maximum of 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for target changing.

Lane hogging will not be tolerated.

The Range Officers instructions must be followed at all times.

Serious infringement of the new rules may lead to disciplinary action being taken by the Committee.

If you have to use the W.C. <u>you must</u> clean the toilet and all surfaces you have touched and wash your hands. Please use the disposable paper towel provided and dispose of it in the bin.

NO FOOD or DRINK of any kind is permitted on the Club premises.

Hand sanitiser, anti-bacterial wipes and disposable towels will be provided.
